Guatemala is the northernmost country of the Central American nations; its neighbors are Belize, Honduras, and El Salvador on the east and Mexico on the west and north. In Guatemala there are three main regions - the tropical jungle in the northern lowlands, known as the Petén, the highlands with the heaviest population and the tropical area along the Pacific and Caribbean coasts. Day 1: (Arrival)

Meet at the Aurora International Airport in Guatemala City at the time of your arrival [Arrival Windows between 1 & 3pm or 8 & 10pm]. A shuttle will be waiting to take you to the hotel in Antigua, where you'll meet your guides and the rest of the group. You will have time to freshen up and in the evening we'll meet again for dinner and the welcome briefing.

Day 2: (Pacaya Volcano)

A plentiful continental style breakfast will be served in the hotel. We will be picked up from the hotel lobby at 9am for our trip to the active volcano Pacaya. After about a 1 ½ hour ride, we will arrive at the national park office where we'll find the trail that winds its way along the mountainside. The hike up to the base of the cone will take about 1 ½ hours, after which, those who want to tackle the cone can do so. The hike up the cone is at about a 40-degree angle and is made up of loose scree and ash, so it's a "two steps up and then slide back a step" type of terrain. This last 500ft will take an additional 1 ½ hours to ascend and descend (round trip). After that, we'll take a break to enjoy a picnic lunch at the base of the volcano, from there head back down to rendezvous with the vehicle and return back to our hotel in Antigua. Arrival will be between 3 and 4pm. Showers will be welcomed and clean clothes donned and then we are off to dinner.

Day 3: (Las Tierras Altas – Mountain Bike Ride)

After breakfast we'll head to the bike shop and get fitted for our bike ride. This ride will be a 20 mile cross-country type ride through the agricultural region northwest of Antigua. An early afternoon return brings us back for lunch with some downtime walking around Antigua. We'll have the chance to loosen our limbs with some salsa classes and then relax during and

after dinner. **Note** - An easier ride around the Almolonga Valley visiting the surrounding pueblos and ruins is available. The ride covers about 15 miles and is over dirt, cobblestone and concrete.

Day 4: (2-day Lago Atitlan Trip)

After breakfast we'll pack up our supporting vehicle with our gear and bikes and hit the road for a day of adventure. We'll drive about 1 ¾ hours to our starting location at a rural mountain top school near Las Trampas. At this point we'll grab the bikes and hit the road for a 25 mile ride that will take us along winding mountain roads, passing beautiful indigenous towns in the countryside with amazing views. Lunch will be served along the way prepared by our support vehicle at an incredible vista 2000 ft above the lake. Upon our arrival into Panajachel we'll jump aboard a local boat shuttle as we head over to our cliff-side hotel. While there, you will have the opportunity to rest and take a warm shower followed by a dinner of champions. Post dinner we'll relax under the stars and digest in our cozy wood-fired hot tub.

Day 5: (2nd day Lago Atitlan Trip)

After a relaxing breakfast at 8am at the hotel we set off for an hour and a half in sea kayaks to a nearby indigenous lake side town. From here we leave the boats and head off on foot for about a 2 ½ hour hike back to the hotel following the contours of the lake shore. Once back at the hotel, we'll collect our gear and take a boat shuttle back to Panajachel where we'll have lunch. A 2 ½ hour ride back to Antigua, shower at our hotel and then dine at another wonderful Antigua restaurant.

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Day 6: (Whitewater rafting on the Nahaulate River)

After an early breakfast we'll be transferred an hour or so out of town, to the put in location at the banks of the Rio Nahaulate. After a safety and orientation talk, we'll board the rafts and begin our descent down the river. There is no better way to wrap up our adventure trip than tumbling our way down an exciting blend of tunnel chutes to big wave trains with great action. We'll enjoy lunch on the riverside and relax a bit before jumping back into our boats. At the take-out, we'll be transferred to our awaiting vehicles for the ride back to Antigua. We'll get back with plenty of time to clean up and head out for dinner at one of Antigua's many delicious restaurants.

After enjoying the sounds of the forest and the ruins of days past, we arrive at the Flores hotel for dinner and relaxation.
